SUBJECT: TRANSFER OF MATERIAL FROM TSL TO CERN

Dear Prof. Ekström,

Since the CELSIUS storage ring has been closed, CERN is interested in taking over some of the material now becoming available.

In particular we are interested in the following magnets:

- 3 bending magnets (BM_C5, BM_F6, BM_F10)
- 16 quadrupole magnets including available spare parts
- 5 dipole correction magnets

They fit the specifications of magnets required for the CTF3 project (<http://ctf3.home.cern.ch/ctf3/CTFindex.htm>).

CTF3, the CLIC (Compact Linear Collider) Test Facility is presently being built to answer important technical issues for CLIC as a possible future linear e^+/e^- collider. CTF3 is relying on a strong international collaboration with contributions from many laboratories.

We suggest that the ownership of equipment supplied by "The Svedberg Laboratory TSL" shall automatically transfer to CERN upon the completion of their safe delivery to the CERN site.

We propose that the detailed conditions for the transportation and transfer of property shall be treated in a separate document to be agreed between TSL and CERN. For CERN Dr. Wilhelm Kalbreier will be in charge for setting up this document in close collaboration with the responsible person nominated from your side.
